GAMARAI INFORMATION

Your registration includes:

MONDAY: Lunch at 716 Main Restaurant in Humbolt and admission to the Albert City Historical Museum. Among their collection is a 1903 Ford Model A, no not our Model A but Henry's first automobile of the Ford Motor Company. This is one of about 1800 Model A's built.

TUESDAY: We have arranged for a private two-hour Queen II cruise complete with our evening dinner on West Lake Okoboji. There is a bar and restroom facilities on the boat.

WEDNESDAY: Admission to Bogenrief Studios. Over the years, Bogenrief Studios has grown from a small house in Seney, IA, to a studio with a national reputation for exquisite works of art in stained and beveled glass. Lunch in a park and Yesterday's Memories & Truck Museum. Yesterday's Memories Museum houses 1000's of items from the years gone by. Almost 80 years ago, the Vander Haag family began to collect trucks and cars. John Vander Haag senior opened Southside Junkyard in 1939 which sold recycled automotive and truck parts, eventually dropping the automotive side of the business and focused solely on trucks. The family began to collect things like children's toys, fuel pumps, historic trucks, cars, and mechanical implements.

THURSDAY: Admission to Okoboji Classic Cars. This one-of-a-kind facility houses a solo painted mural that is over 28,000 sq. feet, plus indoor diorama scenes. All of the artwork was painted by resident artist Jack Rees. This magnificent scenery brings our visitors back to Spencer's Grand Avenue where they can browse vintage storefronts. The Winchester Museum also features the artwork of Jake Rees memorializing Winchester's venture into the hardware and camping business. At one time there were Winchester Hardware stores throughout the country. The Shrine of the Grotto of the Redemption is a religious creation that is enjoyed by thousands every year. and the pizza party. Please bring your own drinks to the pizza party.

FRIDAY: Admission to Camp Algona POW Museum. Dedicated to preserving the history of the Prisoner of War camp that housed 10,000 German Prisoners of War in Algona, Iowa from 1943-1946.

GAMARAI Cancellation policy: We will make every effort to refund money paid if you need to cancel your trip. Before August 15, 2025 - 100% refundable. After August 15, we will refund any money not spent (t-shirts are ordered August 15 so they are not refundable). Cancellations up until Monday September 21 are subject to what we have spent. There will be no refund to anyone who does not show up and does not notify us.

Our tour kicks off with a driver's meeting at 7:30 on Monday morning, under the canopy in front of the Hyatt.

Monday the 21st through Wednesday the 23rd we stay at the Reston Inn & Suites, 10 11th St SE, Spencer, IA.

They have a combination of Single Kings, Double Queens and 4 handicap accessible rooms that each have a Single King Bed.

This is a 2-story hotel with no elevator. They have 20+ first floor rooms but they are on a first come first serve basis.

Each room is \$119 + tax per night. There is a pet fee of \$30/pet/night. To book your room phone 712-580-4077 and mention the GAMARAI group rate.

The final night, Thursday the 24th, is in Algona at the Brookstone Lodge & Suites, 1909 US-18, Algona, IA. Their phone number is 515-200-0030.

This one is \$93.54 including tax, with the GAMARAI group rate. Again, a two-story hotel without an elevator, so first come first served on the main floor.
