Refinishing the Woodgrain on your Model A

Q: Which Model A's received a Woodgrain Finish?

A: Good question, especially in light of our Winter Tech Meet on Woodgraining. Saturday, Feb 21st at 9 AM in the Polk City Public Library.

Ford furnished their Deluxe Models with upgraded appointments, including a faux woodgrain finish on the dashboard and window trim. This factory finish achieved a natural woodgrain look by using a print transfer technique over a mahogany base coat paint color. The Club has now purchased the tool kit required to duplicate this printed mahogany woodgrain finish.

Deluxe Body Styles that used a Woodgrain Finish:

1929-31	Town Sedan	155-all	Stipple Mahogany *
1930-31	Fordor (blind back)	170-B Dlx	Stipple Mahogany *
1930-31	Deluxe Coupe	45-B Dlx	Stipple Mahogany *
1930-31	Cabriolet	68-B, C	Stipple Mahogany
1931	S/W Town Sedan	160-B, C	Stipple Mahogany
1931	Deluxe Tudor	55-B Dlx	Stipple Mahogany
1931	Victoria	190-A	Stipple Mahogany
1931	Convertible Sedan	400-A	Butt Walnut **

The parts that get woodgrained include the dash, windshield pillars, header finish strip and all window trim, (front & rear door, quarter and rear windows).

* Header finish strip painted upper body color.

** Walnut pattern plate (\$250) is not included in the Club's tool inventory.
