Cleaning Procedure for beautiful white wall tires.

- Dilute CRUD REMOVER to at least a 25% solution. See label instructions.
1:4 = 1 part cleaner and 3 parts water for 4 parts total solution.
- Wet tires completely with a water hose.
- Spray on CRUD REMOVER and let soak in for a couple minutes. Do not let solution dry on tires.
- Give the white walls a quick scrub with a brush, more on stubborn stains.
- Rinse completely with a water hose.
